CALL & RESPONSE: POLITICS OF LEADERSHIP AND CIVIL RIGHTS

The 2012 Seneca Falls Dialogues is coming soon! The event is scheduled for October 19-21, 2012, in Seneca Falls, the Upstate New York community known as the birthplace of women's rights. Thousands flock to this historic village to see first hand exactly where Elizabeth Cady Stanton convened the first Women's Rights Convention in 1848. Organizers have been finalizing what they assure will be "even more exciting" than the highly-lauded 2008 and 2010 events which featured keynote speakers from the United Nations, the United States Congress, along with Women's Rights Authors and Activists.

Gathering students from universities across New York State, the Seneca Falls Dialogues was created to provide a focal point for discussion of women's rights. Topics range from the history of the struggle for equality and where we are in that struggle today, to analysis and discussion of the social, economic, and political implications of the battle. The 2012 theme will be "Politics of Leadership and Civil Rights." Submissions for presentations were reviewed by the University Alliance, AAUW, and organizers of the Dialogues.
